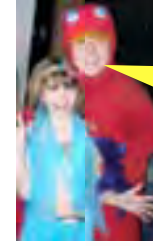

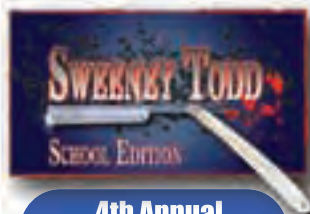

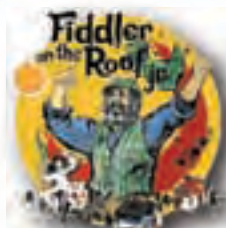

Whether it be the arts field, like these grads on our walk of fame, or in the case of '09 Graduate Eryn Berquist who is taking her 8 years of being a student at Stage Right and applying those experiences and skill-sets to being a communications major at James Madison, Stage Right's goal is to create well-rounded students who use the Stage Right Experience to become the best leader, innovator, team-player, and free-thinker that they can be.

Our student's dreams begin here, but not all of them have to end on stage.

ACTING
1, 2, 3 AND ADVANCED

In the beginner level, students learn the basics of theatre terminology, as well as, understanding the basic precepts of acting. All instruction is based in the Meisner method and focuses on the reality of doing, text analysis and character study. All student levels also explore creative play through improv warm-ups and work on monologues and scenes. In the advanced level, students take part in the Pittsburgh Public Theatre's Shakespeare monologue and scene contest, (*In the past 7 years Stage Right has produced 2 winners and 5 finalists*) and working on long form scenes and monologues that explore the work of today's best playwrights.



JAZZ 1, 2, 3, 4

Beginners learn terminology, counting, across the floor and center combinations. Technique is highly stressed. Students are introduced to different styles of choreography, from hip-hop to musical theatre. In jazz 4 students learn to work at a faster pace as well as intensifying the level of warm-ups and across the floor combinations. Jazz 4 will be twice a week in order to improve flexibility, stamina, technique, preparation for auditioning and choreography. Attendance for this level will be mandatory unless absence has been approved by the instructor.



MOVEMENT FOR ACTORS

This is a class for non-dancers that concentrates on styles and becoming comfortable with movement and the body. The class will work on using the body effectively to tell a story and physically become a character as well as working on partnering and lifts. A must for those who are interested in auditioning for collegiate Musical Theatre programs.

HIP-HOP

The basics of Hip-Hop are taught and applied to the variety of combinations and choreography used in music videos, new Broadway productions and other entertainment venues where hip-hop is used in the professional world.



TAP 1, 2, 3, 4

Students learn the importance of counting, rhythms and using the floor as an instrument. Basic steps and terminology are covered and students learn to put together across the floor combinations as well as routines from great tap musicals.

BALLET 1, 2, 3, POINTE

Providing the core of all dance, Ballet 1 students do barre work and learn the basics of technique. In Ballet 2, and 3 barre and across the floor work become more complex. Pointe work is offered for those that meet the instructors criteria.

VOICE 1, 2 & 3

Rachael Braun heads a program that stresses healthy singing. In Voice 1, students learn the basics of breathing, tonality and support as well as learning songs from all styles of music. In Voice 2, students concentrate on musical theatre pieces and reaffirming technique. In Voice 3 there is a concentration on building their repertoire for future auditions and polishing vocal production.



MASTER AUDITION CLASS

A must for any student with an interest in auditioning for Acting or Musical Theatre college programs. Open to Juniors and SeniorS, Instructor Tony Marino prepares you with a step-by-step process to pick the best material and prepare it fully. Help is also provided in picking the school and program that best suits the student as well as scheduling college auditions.

MUSICAL THEATRE EXPERIENCE!



Previously known as Musical Theatre Workshop this class is now offered by itself, as well as, being part of one our 'Stages'. It has been restructured to better serve the varied needs and interests of our students. Each semester will now include the exploration of one musical featuring two numbers - the exploration of 1 play - that will feature two scenes and possibly a monologue - and finally each semester will focus on one choreographer and learn and perform one of their most famous numbers. (*Note: this is for the first three semesters, our fourth semester Experience class will serve as rehearsal for our end of year Student Company Productions.*)
